- 4. Life Application God calls for us to not just be a hearer of His word, but a doer also. (James 1:22). This means that God expects for us to apply what we learn about Him in our everyday lives. This section of the study is to help you think about the ways to apply what you learn from the course to your everyday life.
- 5. **Memory Scriptures** Scriptures that support key concepts in the course will be highlighted. We encourage you to memorize these scriptures by meditating on them until they are hidden in your heart. When you hide God's word in your heart, it makes it hard for the enemy to deceive you. In this way, you are less likely to sin against God. (Psalm 119:11)

Introduction to Course Twenty-Five

This is part 7 of the series on Finding Your Purpose and Destiny. In this course we discuss Spiritual Crowns also known as Heavenly Crowns. We go through 3 questions as we review



each on: How do you get the crown? When do you get the crown? Since we know that some crowns are given on earth. And, can you lose the crown? All of these crowns are outlined in the New Testament

Synopsis	Spiritual Crowns are given to us as a part of our heavenly reward. Each crown is awarded for different things as outlined in the bible. The bible also has clear instructions given to us on how to maintain our crowns. Earning a crown shows that you have reached a level of authority in the spiritual realm in that area. God has given everyone of us an opportunity to earn the crowns and thankfully being "highly qualified" or having a degree in theology is not one of them. This allows all of us to work for these on the same equal footing regardless of race, gender, socioeconomic status or geographical location.	
Key Vocabulary/ Concepts	 Crown Greek - Stephanos: that which surrounds, i.e. a crown Phonetic Spelling : (stef'-an-os) Strong's Concordance 4735 4735 stéphanos – properly, a wreath (garland), awarded to a victor in the ancient athletic games (like the Greek Olympics); the crown of victory (versus 1238 /diádēma, "a royal crown"). [4735 (stéphanos) is used of a plaited wreath ("crown"), like the one made of thorns placed on the head of Christ at His trial (Mt 27:29, Mk 15:17; Jn 19:2,5).]

This will help you to see the warnings that God has clearly outlined in Revelations 2 – 3 as it relates to your crowns.
Life Application	Have you been able to identify if you already have a crown? There are many things that God has already given to us and sometimes we can be unaware of them. Now that you know the requirements for each of the crowns:
