How to Use This Guide

This self-study guide is a companion document to the video course "Prayer: The Lord's Prayer - Part 2"

This guide will help you get a comprehensive look at how to find your purpose and destiny in life by looking at one of the ways in which Jesus can reveal your purpose and destiny to you.

1. **Synopsis of Key Learning** - The synopsis will provide summaries of key points from the video that are important for you to understand and serve as foundational knowledge for the next course in the learning series.
2. **Important Vocabulary and Concepts** - This study guide will provide explanation of important words or ideas that are critical to understanding biblical truth.
3. **Deeper Learning** - The more you know and understand about who God is and how He works, the deeper in love you fall. God wants to have a deep and abiding relationship with you. He desires for you to know Him. This section of guide will give you additional insights into the teaching from the video for you to study on your own. If you have questions, there will be mentoring moments in the online school for you to get your questions answered.
4. **Life Application** - God calls for us to not just be a hearer of His word, but a doer also. (James 1:22). This means that God expects for us to apply what we learn about Him in our everyday lives. This section of the study is to help you think about the ways to apply what you learn from the course to your everyday life.
5. **Memory Scriptures** - Scriptures that support key concepts in the course will be highlighted. We encourage you to memorize these scriptures by meditating on them until they are hidden in your heart. When you hide God's word in your heart, it makes it hard for the enemy to deceive you. In this way, you are less likely to sin against God. (Psalm 119:11)

Introduction to Course Thirty-One

In this course we will look at the Lord's prayer and show how it is a model prayer or how it can be used as a template for our own prayers. This was the one prayer that Jesus shared with His disciples when they asked Him to teach them how to pray. This is part 2 of 3 parts on the Lord's prayer where we will examine Luke 11:2-3

Prayer: The Lord's Prayer - Part 2	
Synopsis	In Luke 11:2-3, we look at bringing God's kingdom from heaven to earth through prayer and understanding His will. Then examine what it means to ask God to give us this day our daily bread. Bread, which is food, is needed to daily sustain our lives and the bible makes a comparison between our need for communion with God as a necessity for living.
Key Vocabulary/ Concepts	Bread - Strong's Concordance 740 <i>ártos</i> – properly, bread; (figuratively) divine provision; all the sustenance God supplies to yielded believers scene-by-scene to live in His preferred-will (2307 / <i>thélēma</i>).
Deeper Learning	<p>The definition of Bread is sustenance to live scene-by-scene in God's preferred (perfected) will. Thinking of it this way we see that the way to stay in God's perfect will, we need to eat of the Bread of Life which is simply spending time in the presence of Jesus and communing with Him.</p> <p>In doing so we would have a better understanding of His will and know what to pray to bring heaven to earth.</p> <p>Reflecting on your own prayer life, can you think of a time when you prayed for something and then realized later that you were happy God did not answer that prayer?</p>
Life Application	<p>Understanding "give us this day our daily bread" means that we will have our needs met on a daily basis. To truly live this life it means that faith is required. There can be no anxiety about how our bills will be paid ahead of time because this bible verse is saying that at the moment when we need something we will have it.</p> <p>Are there areas where you wish you could change God's mind? Using the list of His attributes identify the attribute that will bring you peace to allow Him to make the decision in your life.</p> <p>Here is an A to Z list of the attributes of God</p> <p>Here is a list of the Names of God</p> <p>This list doesn't include every name but this is a great list to start with.</p>
