# Prayer For Protection Psalm 91 - Part 1

### How to Use This Guide

This self-study guide is a companion document to the video course "Prayer for Protection - Psalm 9, Part 1"

4. **Life Application** - God calls for us to not just be a hearer of His word, but a doer also. (James 1:22). This means that God expects for us to apply what we learn about Him in our everyday lives. This section of the study is to help you think about the ways to apply what you learn from the course to your everyday life.
5. **Memory Scriptures** - Scriptures that support key concepts in the course will be highlighted. We encourage you to memorize these scriptures by meditating on them until they are hidden in your heart. When you hide God's word in your heart, it makes it hard for the enemy to deceive you. In this way, you are less likely to sin against God. (Psalm 119:11)

### Introduction to Course Thirty-Three

In this course, we will look at Part 1 of a 2 Part series on Psalm 91 which is a Prayer for Protection. This Psalm is a very powerful tool that can be used when the need arises for God's protection. In Part 1 we cover verses 1 - 13 of Psalm 91. God clearly outlines who receives protection from using this Psalm

Prayer for Protection - Psalm 91, Part 1	
<b>Synopsis</b>	<p>Psalm 91:1 “He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.”</p> <p>The first verse of this Psalm says the ones who will receive protection from this Psalm. Living under the covering of God’s shadow requires you to have a relationship with Him and some level of comfort to stay in that place.</p> <p>The Psalm goes on to show that this protection is from seen and unseen enemies and from known and unknown and it covers us day and night.</p>
<b>Key Vocabulary/ Concepts</b>	<p><b>Dwell - Strong’s Concordance 3427</b> <i>yashab</i> to live, abide, remain, inhabit, to sit, abode, married, occupied, resident, peaceful.</p>
<b>Deeper Learning</b>	<p>As with many other things in Christianity your intimate relationship with your Lord and Savior Jesus Christ has many benefits.</p> <p>One such benefit of your intimacy is that you are protected. Therefore, the key to unlock the power of this Psalm is intimacy with God. It is only through this intimacy that you could dwell in His Presence under His Shadow. The idea that we are covered in all areas at all times of the day is reassuring. Much like the Armor of God, this Psalm doesn’t stay active 24 hours of the day. We need to read it aloud when we feel nervous or even afraid of some situations, circumstances, people or places. When this happens we have Psalm 91 that we can declare into the atmosphere, activating the sword of the spirit and know that we are covered.</p> <p>This coverage God does Himself, and sometimes warrior angels are dispatched plus we have our very own guardian angel who keeps us from danger.</p> <p>In a world where bad things can happen both to the righteous and the unrighteous (Matthew 5:45), it is good to know that we have such a powerful tool in Psalm 91.</p>
<b>Life Application</b>	<p>Do you struggle with fear? If you do, read this Psalm aloud every morning and see the difference it makes in your day. You can also read it at night if you don’t feel safe in your home or when you are going into a situation</p>

	<p>where you feel unsafe. Remember that God covers you in the way that He is sending you. So if the Lord asked you to do something this Psalm is your covering.</p>
<p><b>Memory Scriptures</b></p>	<p>(Isaiah 41:10) <i>“Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you; I will surely help you; I will uphold you with My right hand of righteousness.”</i></p>

Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.*

And ten thousand at your right hand;

And see the reward of the wicked.*

<sup>9</sup> *Because you have made the LORD, who is my refuge,  
Even the Most High, your dwelling place,*

<sup>10</sup> *No evil shall befall you,

<sup>11</sup> *For He shall give His angels charge over you,  
To keep you in all your ways.*

<sup>12</sup> *In their hands they shall bear you up,

I will be with him in trouble;  
I will deliver him and honor him.*

*<sup>16</sup> With long life I will satisfy him,*

*And show him My salvation.”*
