Introduction to Course Fifty Two

In this course you will learn about the Prophetic intercessor, also known as the Watchman.

Intercession is praying for the needs of others. A Prophetic Intercessor is someone who has the ability to see into the future prophetically for the purpose of praying and also to prophesy about events to come. These events can either be good and related to future blessings or they can also be a warning.

The prophetic intercessor will then pray based on what was shown prophetically and also share based on the instructions of the Lord.

The Prophetic Intercessor, The Watchman

Synopsis

Intercession is praying for the needs of others and this is a needed role in the body of Christ. The prophetic intercessor is an intercessor who also flows in the gift of prophecy along with other spiritual gifts.

The prophetic intercessor is also known as the watchman because the role is seen as someone who is at a level in the realm of the spirit (like a watchman's tower) where their vantage point gives them the ability to see into the future the events that will occur.

Key Vocabulary/ Concepts

Hebrew Strong's Concordance - 6822

Tsaphah: To look out, watch, keep watch, spy, observe

Usage: The Hebrew verb "tsaphah" primarily means to look out or to keep watch. It conveys the idea of observing with intent or vigilance, often in the context of a watchman or someone who is on the lookout for approaching events or dangers. This term is used both in literal and metaphorical senses, indicating physical watching as well as spiritual or prophetic observation.

Cultural and Historical Background: In ancient Israel, the role of a watchman was crucial for the safety and security of a city. Positioned on city walls or towers, watchmen were responsible for observing the horizon for any signs of approaching enemies or messengers. This role required vigilance, discernment, and the ability to communicate effectively with those inside the city. The concept of watching also extended to spiritual leaders and prophets, who were tasked with discerning and warning the people of spiritual dangers or divine messages.

<p>Deeper Learning</p>	<p>One of the spiritual gifts that is used by the Watchman in this role is the gift of discerning of spirits, which is different from discernment.</p> <p>Everyone can get discernment from reading the word of God. Discernment is the ability to judge something correctly. When we read God’s word we can easily discern when something is right or wrong.</p> <p>Discerning of spirits is the ability to discern the source of the information you are hearing or seeing whether it is from God, someone’s flesh, or it is from the enemy. This is crucial so that you know how to handle the situations observed.</p>
<p>Life Application</p>	<p>Has God ever revealed to you something about someone else that no one else knew? How did you handle that information?</p> <p>The job of the prophetic intercessor is to pray for what they see or hear in the realm of the spirit. When we see something bad, our first thought should be, how can I pray for this to be made right so that this person or situation lines up with God’s will? It is the job of the prophetic intercessor to pray for Christ to be formed in someone so that they are transformed into the image of Christ. Not to judge them but to approach it with God’s love and will to redeem and restore that person. Jesus said that He only does what He sees the Father doing (John 5:19) and that He only says what the Father told Him to say (John 12:49) this should also be the objective of the prophetic intercessor.</p> <p>There may be occasions when the Lord will let you know that you need to actually speak up and say something to that person or groups of people. At this point the prophetic gift is being used to deliver information to people who may not have seen what you saw while you were in the “watchman’s tower” in the realm of the spirit.</p> <p>The Lord can show you prophetically world events that are about to happen and He can also show you what would prevent them from happening if they are bad things. When we pray we can divert these events. And, this is the very reason you were shown this to begin with.</p>
